CEMETERY TRUSTEES MEETING

October 14, 2014

This meeting was called to order at 7:38am. In attendance: Marie Grella; Bill Belvin; Bruce Berry Sexton; Pat Delisle Executive Assistant, Carl Norwood, resident.

Chestnut Hill Cemetery: There have been inquiries regarding burials at Chestnut Hill Cemetery now that there appears to be lots available. Carl agreed to cover the cost of the archeologist, the removal of stumps and placing them over the rock wall. There was a concern regarding bringing heavy equipment through the cemetery. Carl had gotten permission from the abutter to bring the equipment over his land. Carl received a letter from the Trustees with the cost due of \$1627.34 and another \$3,000 for the "Right to Inter" for 6 graves. Carl is hoping for a credit on the cost of the cemetery lots. He is looking for a 12 grave lot. Bill Belvin asks for input from the others, Bruce Berry stated that Leighton White called him regarding spreading the loam. Bill refers to the Dinkel lot and the precedent set at that time. The resident paid for all the landscaping. Bill asks how many graves are now available. Perry states that there would possibly be 54. Carl believes that there are many lots now available for internment. Marie states that the Town will benefit from the work that was done and that this should be discussed when Peter Bergin is available.

Bill makes a motion to table this discussion until the next meeting, seconded by Marie. Motion passes.

Memorandum of Understanding – Bill Belvin, Brad Galinson and Jim O’Mara met regarding the M.O.U., they are making progress. There are still several issues outstanding. For instance: Who has the right to sign a "Right to Inter"? In the past the signing of 'Deed's were put on the agenda for the Board of Selectman to be signed at a Selectman meeting, due to the time restraints this was changed with the authorization of Terry Knowles and Atty. Drescher, however Bill Belvin is going to check with Terry Knowles to confirm or change.

Discussion Items:

Revenues such as grave opening costs, and lot costs should be detached from the trust funds and deposited into the general fund.

Disinterment of the remains from grave #906: We will need identification and relationship verification. The charge incurred would be the same as a grave opening. We would purchase the lot back at the same price it was purchased, \$300.00.

Issuing "Right to Inter" at Chestnut Hill Cemetery; This can be done once the new section is laid out.
