4	In attendance were: Chairman, Marie Grella, Lisa Eastland, Cynthia Dokmo, Bruce Berry
5	Cemetery Sexton, Pat Delisle, Executive Assistant.
6	The meeting was called to order by Chairman Marie Grella at 7:35 am
7	The meeting was caned to order by Chairman Warie Grena at 7.33 am
	<u>G2Plus1</u> - Doug Grenier presented the suitability plan from 1996 completed by Altos
8	
9	Engineering, giving and explanation. This suitability study reflects wetland boundary. A
10	conceptual Development Plan and refinement should be done to the master plan as time &
11	conditions have changed. Altos Engineering is the contractor with G2Plus1 being a
12	subcontractor. Doug is unsure were Altos stands on the plans as of today. Lisa asks about the
13	number of graves, this would be determined once the layout and grave types are agreed upon by
14	the Cemetery Trustees. Phase I was calculated at \$108,000That cost would be adjusted to meet
15	today's cost and need. In 2014 it was estimated at \$164,000. The Cemetery Trustees would have
16	to have a set amount from the Attorney Generals office. The first step would be to have a
17	boundary survey, design and construction, in 2013, was estimated at \$150,000. \$40,700 was
18	estimated for design compensation. The total time to establish the soils would be between 18 and
19	24 months.
20	Cynthia states that the Board of Selectman should be asked if Altos Engineering can be g  If, by
21	chance, Alto Engineering were not able to be grandfathered, and this survey went out to bid, the
22	bid would have to state the Town of Amherst owns the survey once it is complete. Cynthia states
23	that the Board of Selectman should be asked if Altos can be grandfathered, prior to having the
24	survey completed. She asks Bruce for a letter explaining Altos Engineering's involvement and
25	what they have previously completed for the Trustees. From a fee basis Altos Engineering would
26	be beneficial to the Town.
27	The Cemetery Trustees thank Doug for his time and presentation.

29	<u>Citizens' Forum</u> - There were no citizens present

34	Discussion and approval of letter to the "Trustees of the Trust fund" for payment to the town for
35	expenses for FY15. Cynthia has researched how the invoice from the Town was paid in 2014 and were
36	the funds were withdrawn. Cynthia makes a motion to use the 2015 income as follows:
37	\$395.68 from Putnam; \$796.29 from Wilkins; \$2,669.61 from other; and \$20,882.45 from Perpetual care:
38	totaling \$24,739.03, This motion is seconded by Lisa all in favor, motion passes

40	Bench at Cricket Corner Cemetery: Cynthia makes a motion to give Marie Authority to make a
41	decision on the placement of a bench on Common Ground within Cricket Corner Cemetery, seconded by
42	Lisa all in favor, motions passes.

44	<u>Circus at Forestview Cemetery</u> : There is a potential for Circus Smirkus to rent Forestview Cemetery
45	creating revenue of between \$20,000.00 and \$30,000. This will include the installation of up to 180 tent
46	poles. Cynthia will set up an appointment with Terry Knowles regarding usage of Forestview Cemetery.
47 40	Lisa makes a motion to deny this usage, seconded by Cynthia, all in favor, motion passes.
