1 **Cemetery Trustees Meeting Minutes** 2 17 Jan 2019 3 4 Attendees: Marie Grella, Lisa Eastland, Cynthia Dokmo, Dwight Brew, Gordon Leedy, Perry Day, 5 Sexton and Pat Delisle 6 7 Called to order at 1pm Thursday 1/17/19. 8 9 Citizen's forum: No one present 10 11 Marie Grella made a motion to approve the minutes of Nov. 18, 2018, seconded by Cynthia 12 Dokmo. 13 14 Budget review: There were some budget transfers all done within the 4195 budget. 15 16 **Deliberative session** will be held February 6, Wednesday. Dwight will be attending the 17 deliberative session and will speak for the Cemetery Trustees. The Town auditor says that all 18 expenditures need to be budgeted. Cynthia would like to have a slide of the Cemetery Trustees 19 Trust funds balances. In the event that someone asks about funds it can be shown that the 20 Trustees have more than enough money to pay for their expenditures in the future. The 21 Trustees of the Trust Funds would have the latest figures. Dwight feels that it would be helpful 22 to have the funds that can cover the expenditures highlighted in some way at the deliberative 23 session. 24 25 Discussion regarding Forestview Cemetery: Gordon Leedy shared a copy of the proposal and 26 the executed contract base mapping, flood plain delineation, and wetland delineation and so 27 forth, that work is done but the contract is still active. Gordon generated a conceptual plan on 28 Sept. 5, 2018 (attached to the minutes), and the Cemetery Trustees were in agreement that this 29 would be the general direction to move in. The Cemetery Trustees may need to go to the Planning Board for a site plan review, however, it is not a formal site plan since this is a 30 31 governmental use, it would be more of a notification taking comment from the planning board. 32 This contract is based on a bid the easiest way to proceed would be to create addendums to 33 this contract. 34 Lisa makes a motion to accept Meridian proposal, seconded by Cynthia, all in favor, motion 35 passes. Gordon will get in touch with Ken (from Meridian) and ask him for a contract 36 amendment based on the new requested information on grave set up. Discussion follows 37 regarding establishing graves, lot sales, the size of the grave (currently 40i" wide, suggesting 38 48" wide) and the buffer needed between each lot. Also discussed was creating an 39 entrance/exit at another location 40 41 Gordon will obtain a map from Meridian.
