55 NRPC Aggregation Power Purchase

- 5657 Town Administrator O'Mara advised the Board that the work w
- Town Administrator O'Mara advised the Board that the work with NRPC regarding the Electricity
 Aggregate has been completed. All documents have been reviewed by legal counsel and the
- 59 consortium consists of eight towns and five school districts. Integrity has been selected as the
- 60 electricity provider and is locked in at \$7.85 per kilowatt hour as opposed to the PSNH rate of \$9.23
- 61 per kilowatt hour. This price is slightly higher than our current provider Hess; however, Hess is no
- 62 longer going to be providing the service one the contract year ends. This will be a nine month
- agreement and no motions from the Board are necessary. This information is advisory only.
