7	The meeting was called to order by Cynthia Dokmo at 7:35 am

9	Citizens' Forum- There was no citizen comments.
10	
11	Minutes of November 20, 2016 – Cynthia makes a motion to accept the minutes as submitted,
12	seconded by Lisa Eastland, all in favor, motion passes.
13	
14	Cynthia met with Jim O'Mara and Bill Drescher regarding the warrant article and the Cy-Pres petition.
15	The Cemetery Trustees plan to ask the attorney generals' office for 75% of the total cost. The warrant
16	article will ask to withdraw money from the Cemetery lot trust funds and is as follows:
17 18	"Article for withdrawing funds only from expendable trust for cost of construction
19	To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$, (gross budget) for the purpose of
20	defraying costs associated with construction of the Forestview Cemetery and to authorize the withdrawal
21	of said sum from the available balance in the expendable trust established pursuant to RSA 31:19-a, by
22	the passage of warrant article No, at the March 2017 annual town meeting, which expendable trust is
23	known as the Cemetery Lot Fund."
24	
25	Cynthia makes a motion to request \$150,000 via Cy-Pres, using the perpetual care trust fund. Lisa
26 27	seconds, all in favor, motion passes. The Cemetery Trustees would like to set up a table at the deliberative session 5 (Feb. 8, 2017) for informational hand-outs regarding Forestview Cemetery construction and the
27 28	Cy-Pres petition.
28 29	Cy-ries pedulon.
30	A discussion regarding tomb fees will be added to the agenda for the January meeting.
31	
32	Lisa makes a motion to pay the invoice from Pennichuck Water out of the General Supply General
33	Ledger account. This is seconded by Cynthia, motion passes.
34	
35	The next Cemetery Trustee meeting is scheduled for the third Thursday in January. January 19 th at
