Meeting called to order at 1:00

**Citizen Forum:** No citizens present

**Minutes:** May 8, 2020, review of these minutes was postponed to the next meeting in July.

**Forestview Cemetery Plans:** Street naming and grave/lot numbering  
Rules & Regulations. Some changes were discussed in regards to headstones, and  
plantings. This will be discussed again at a later meeting.

Forestview Cemetery Flagpole status: The flagpole is currently on hold.

Town owned lot: resident burials. The Trustees will revisit this topic in July.

Approval for a new sign at Meadowview: Marie would like the same size as the one at  
Spaulding Field (The Johnson sign) and attached to the two gates entering the  
cemetery.

Discussion regarding new lawn mower: With the addition of Forestview Cemetery, the  
cemetery should have its own lawn mower. Perry calculates the cost in the vicinity of  
\$10,000 for a zero turn lawn mower. The mower will need to be trailered to travel  
between Meadowview and Forestview Cemeteries. Cynthia asks that Perry gets a firm  
estimate.

Report on fire at Meadowview Cemetery: There was a fire set at Meadowview  
Cemetery, the damage was over the back hill and didn't impact the turf at all in the  
cemetery, a couple of the pine trees were scorched. The individuals that set the fire  
were caught and will be performing community service.

Fence painting at Meadowview update: Marie met with volunteers that are painting the  
fence. They are on track to completing it and are doing a great job.

New Business: A letter was received regarding the gravestones needing cleaning, he  
was told that it to do with water leakage. The stones are owned by the families that  
purchased the stone. Families have paid companies to clean the stone. If the Town  
were to clean them they would be liable for any damage as some of the stones are very  
old and need special handling. A reply letter will be send by the Trustees.

A motion is made to adjourn by Marie, seconded by Cynthia, meeting adjourned at  
1:35pm.
