

Cemetery Trustees Meeting  
April 15, 2021

In attendance: Marie Grella, Cynthia Dokmo, Eric Hahn, and Pat Delisle.

Meeting called to order at 1:05

**Citizen Forum:** No citizens present

Cynthia makes a motion to approve the minutes of March 18, 2021 minutes seconded by Marie Grella. Roll call vote is taken Cynthia Dokmo – aye, Marie Grella - aye and this motion passes.

**Updates for Forestview Cemetery Irrigation and Flagpole:** The flagpole will be delivered April 19<sup>th</sup> Perry Day will accept the delivery and arrangements will be made for installation. Andrew Mullin will proceed with the next step. The Garden Club will donation any plants that are left over from the plant sale. It will be presented on flag day June 14<sup>th</sup>. Due to the pandemic, presentation will be limited. The closer we get to the presentation COVID restriction may be lightened allowing more people to attend. The irrigation has been 75 to 85 percent complete. The main problem was that the well had not been used in 7 to 8 years. They have been re-drilled and everything is running a lot better. The final stage will be clean up by the irrigation installer, he is meeting with the contractor to discuss what needs to be done. The demonstration for town personal will be next week.

**Authorizing payment:** A payment was authorized for \$40,000, this was to cover invoice Knots Land Care (Irrigation installation) and Grella & Son Landscaping Inc. (clerk of the work) A payment is needed to pay for a new pump at Forestview Cemetery. Cynthia Dokmo makes a motion to authorize payment up to \$6,000.00 from the Perpetual Care Trust Fund for a new pump at Forestview Cemetery, seconded by Marie. Roll call vote: Cynthia Dokmo – aye, Marie Grella – aye. Motion passes.

**Entrance sign and signs within Forestview Cemetery:** Signs are need for the 4 main roadways (Merrill Way, Arnold Way, Duval Way, and Croteau Way). Marie would like to see the sign going up. Cynthia would like to hear from Perry before this is done to be sure that these are not in the way of any work being done.

The Commission acknowledges The right to Inters at Meadowview Cemetery lots 118J, 87J and 78J and 2 Rights to Inter at Chestnut Hill Cemetery: 5C and 12B

A meeting is scheduled for 10am on Tuesday April 19 to award the bids.

The wreaths have been removed from the cemetery.

A motion is made to adjourn at 1:25.
