The Amherst Supervisors of the Checklist will be in session at the Town Clerk's Office at the Amherst Town Hall on Friday, October 25, 2019 between 7:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. Please note that this will be the last time currently registered voters may change their party affiliation prior to the Presidential Primary, the date of which is still uncertain. Current voters may change their party affiliation by visiting the Town Clerk's office during business hours prior to Oct. 25.

<u>New voters</u> are welcome to register during regular business hours at the Town Clerk's office up until 10 days prior to Election Day or at the polls on Election Day. New voters will need to bring proof of identity, age, citizenship, and Amherst residency. For most voters, the documents that will work include a driver's license or passport for proof of age, identity and citizenship. For those who are naturalized citizens it is helpful to supply naturalization papers but a passport will suffice. To confirm that you are an Amherst resident, you will need a bill or other document that includes your Amherst address.
