Dear James,

It has come to our attention that your business activities, conducted from your residential premises, are in violation of Section 4.3 of the Town of Amherst Zoning Ordinance, which pertains to Residential/Rural Zones.

As part of our ongoing efforts to ensure compliance with zoning regulations within the Town of Amherst, we are committed to assisting you in achieving compliance. We would like to bring to your attention that in accordance with RSA 676:17, as amended, any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance is punishable by a civil fine of up to two hundred seventy-five dollars (\$275) per day. This fine is applicable for every day after the conviction date that the violation continues, or after the date on which the violator received written notice from the municipality that is in violation, whichever date is earlier.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. We anticipate your prompt action to remedy the violation.
