| ARTICLE 34: New Hampshire Resolution for Fair Nonpartisan Redistricting (By Petition) By petition of 25 or more eligible voters of the town of Amherst to see if the town will vote to urge that the New Hampshire General Court, which is obligated to redraw the maps of political districts within the state ollowing the federal census, will ensure fair and effective representation of New Hampshire voters withouterrymandering.  Additionally, these voters ask the town of Amherst to urge the NH General Court to carry out the redistricting is a fair and transparent way through public meetings, not to favor a particular party, to include communities of the rest, and to minimize multi-seat districts.  Furthermore, as the New Hampshire State Constitution, Part 2, Article 11 allows towns of sufficient population to have their own state representatives, not shared with other towns, for the town of Amherst to petition the Representatives properly represent the town's interests.
